



Legal Aid

We offer Civil Legal Aid and Civil Legal Advice and Assistance for certain types of work. We can advise you if you are possibly eligible for Legal Advice and Assistance.

For further information on Legal Aid please contact us or go to the website of the Scottish Legal Aid Board at www.slab.org.uk. If we to make an application on your behalf you will require to provide us of details of your income and expenditure or to confirm which benefits you receive.

If you require to raise proceedings at your local Sheriff Court then in certain circumstances we can submit an application to the Scottish Legal Aid Board on your behalf. The Board will then consider your application and make a decision as to whether it would be reasonable for you to be granted Legal Aid.

The Scottish Legal Aid Board can provide funding to help those who qualify to get legal advice or the assistance of a solicitor. It may be free or you may have to contribute towards the costs of your case.



There are two kinds of help available to you:

1. Advice and Assistance which helps pay for advice from a solicitor.
2. Civil Legal Aid which helps pay for a solicitor to act for you in court.
